NOTE: Suitcases are not permitted. Backpacks are preferred, as students will be walking for approximately 20 minutes to their camping site.

<p><u>Clothing</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2 x long pants • 2 x sets underwear • 2 x pairs shorts • 2 x t-shirts or polo shirts (not singlet tops) • jumper / polarfleece • warm pj's • waterproof jacket (SPC spray-jacket is ok) • bathers • joggers / runners / boots • thongs (for use in shower) • hat – MUST be broad brimmed (eg: school hat) • old joggers (MUST be worn in water during rafting) <p style="text-align: center;">ALL CLOTHING IS TO BE OLD AND MARKED WITH STUDENTS NAME.</p>	<p><u>Other Items</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • pillow • torch with batteries • drink bottle (at least 500ml & full for day one) • sleeping bag • sleeping mat – available from Allgoods or Kmart for less than \$10. • toiletries, including towel • swimming towel • roll on insect repellent – NO aerosol sprays • sunscreen • 2 x sturdy garbage bags for dirty clothes • fresh socks to wear in dining hall during meals • girls – 1 packet of biscuits (to share for suppers) • boys – 1 packet of marshmallows (to share at campfire) • unbreakable coffee mug (not foam cup) • small backpack (suitable to hold jacket, bottle, food, sunscreen etc for daily activities)
